## *Some Examples of Prior Year's Events*

*Last year the girls did a Walk-a-Thon to benefit Mary Mother of God Mission Society, and raised \$2100 for the Vladivostock Mission in Russia to benefit and care for the orphans at a newly re-opened Catholic Church. The year prior they gathered shoes and sent them to orphans in Rwanda, which helped the orphans to legally attend school.*

*They assisted House of Mercy with packing food for the poor, and with parish missions and the parish picnic.*



*They conducted a Girl's Night Out where middle schoolers had a fun evening "getting their nails and hair done." What they really did, though, is learn about the inner attitude of modesty so they can reflect a purity of heart and a dignity as a child of God, with age appropriate talks on dating.*



*The girls made fleece blankets for House of Mercy, ran a fundraiser for the Dominican Sisters at the Linden Monastery, conducted a Priest Appreciation Dinner, made numerous "Surprise" Spiritual Bouquets, and prepared home-made apple and pumpkin pies for Thanksgiving for the parish as a fundraiser for their club.*
